Thanks to all that have been completing work! Everyone has done great. This week, we will keep with the theme of reviewing previous content. Feel free to use whatever sources you have available to complete this assignment. Here is what I would like you to do for this week's work.

- 1. Take a blank sheet of paper and stand it up tall. (portrait)
- 2. Divide the front into three even spaces by drawing lines side to side or horizontally.
- 3. Do the same to the back, but you only need two boxes.
- 4. Each box will be a day's work. 5 boxes = 5 days
- 5. Research and complete the days box. PLEASE spend 20 minutes each day.
- 6. When TOTALLY FINISHED, take a picture of the front and back.
- 7. Send both pictures to me in one email titled WEEK 5 BIOLOGY

The Earth is a patchwork of forests, deserts, grasslands, oceans, lakes and much more. Forests have certain things in common, so do deserts and swamps. Sure, sometimes there are exceptions to the rule. However, a tundra here is very similar to a tundra over there. You probably know where we're going with this. Biomes are regions of land with similar climates, thus similar plants and animals. They can be terrestrial or aquatic.

Pick any 5 biomes of the 10+ possible. Research <u>what the climate is like</u> and <u>what plants and animals live there</u>. Try to show this in a drawing somehow. Draw a cactus, lizard and thermometer for example. Also, <u>mention where the biomes can be found</u>. Write the information underlined above as well as your sketch for each biome.
